

# Rosewall Community Centre

## Kiln Firing cost

Bisque: \$7.50/kg

Mid fire glaze: \$7.50/kg

Stoneware / Earthenware: \$8.50/kg

Per kiln load: \$95 full price; \$90 concession

## Kiln firing guidelines

1. If you are not a current Rosewall Pottery student, please ensure that you include all the relevant information about both your clay and glazes used to ensure they are appropriate to the firing schedule and can be positioned on bats accordingly. Insufficient information may hold up the process of your work. This information can be emailed to Rosewall at [admin@rosewallinc.org.au](mailto:admin@rosewallinc.org.au)
2. Ensure that your work is completely clear of glaze on the base or anywhere it is likely to come into contact with the kiln shelf. If your glaze runs onto the shelves and causes any damage, a replacement cost will be charged.
3. Please be aware that pieces that are deemed too thick or are stuffed with paper may not be fired.
4. Make sure your clay and glazes are compatible i.e., when using a Mid fire clay/ cone 6 you must use a Mid fire glaze/cone 6.
5. Rosewall takes no responsibility for loss or damage of any work. We take great care but ceramics is a very volatile medium and some things are out of our control.
6. If your work causes any damage to the kiln or shelves because you have not followed the above steps, you are liable for repair or replacement costs.

NOTE: After your piece/pieces have been bisque or glaze fired the office will inform you that the work is ready to collect.
